In addition, Spire has assumed the use/development of new and/or existing access roads throughout the Project area.

Spire anticipates utilizing a 90-foot temporary construction right-of-way width (which includes 50-feet permanent easement and 40 feet of temporary workspace). The construction right-of-way will be reduced to 75-feet at waterbody and wetland crossings. An additional 25 feet of temporary workspace will be required through agricultural areas and may be utilized to facilitate road, waterbody and wetland crossings.

Construction and operation of the proposed Project will be regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") among other regulatory agencies. Spire is utilizing the Commission's prefiling process detailed in Section 157.21 of the Commission's regulations, which allows the Commission and other agencies to initiate National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") review prior to Spire filing an application to the Commission. The Commission would need to issue Spire a Certificate of Public

Convenience and Necessity to enable construction and operation of the proposed pipeline. The preliminary Project schedule includes the following target dates:

- July 22, 2016 Commission acceptance into pre-filing; commencement of the NEPA process (pre-filing docket no. PF16-9-000);
- September/October 2016 initiation of biological and cultural resource surveys;
- January 2017 (Anticipated) file final application with Commission;
- September 2017 (Anticipated) NEPA document published;
- December 2017 (Anticipated) Commission decision on application; and
- January 2018 (Anticipated) commence construction activities.

On behalf of Spire, GAI would like to take this opportunity to invite the Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska to participate in the review of this Project as a cooperating agency during the Commission's pre-filing process. We look forward to your involvement in the review of this important Project and appreciate your cooperation.
